

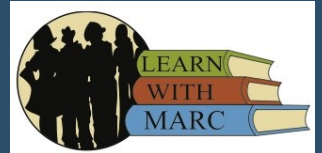

MARC Participates in NLD Pilot Program



The Montcalm Area Reading Council has been accepted as a participant in Adult Learning Communities, the National Literacy Directory's new, free professional development course. The 8-week online cohort will focus on student recruitment, engagement, and persistence, program challenges,

and solutions for rural communities. In addition to instruction, MARC will also receive ongoing coaching, a stipend to implement innovative solutions, and the opportunity to present at the National Center for Families Learning Conference. MARC is one of twelve organizations participating from across the US.
